#### MORNING ASSEMBLY & MORAL VALUES



#### **ADMISSIONS**

- Registration forms for new admissions are available from the third week of December\* every year and selection is made on the basis of written test/interview/draw of lots so as to determine the capacity of the child to pursue the prescribed courses of studies.
- Age: For admission to Std. I the child should complete the age of 05<sup>+</sup> years on 1<sup>st</sup> April of the year of admission.
- Documents required at the time of admission:
- (i) Transfer Certificate (ii) Character Certificate
- (iii) Marks Sheet (iv) Birth Certificate (Municipal Corporation / Gram Panchayat)
- (v) 03 Passport Size Photographs + 02 Photographs along with both the Parents.

#### Registration is not a guarantee for admission

#### WITHDRAWAL PROCEDURE

In case a parent wishes to withdraw his / her ward from the school, application for the same must be rendered in written to the school office & the fees for the month in which request for T.C. is made, will be charged

#### SUBJECT OPTIONS AVAILABLE FOR + 2

#### Science Stream:

Compulsory Subjects-Physics, Chemistry, English

#### **Optional Subjects:**

Group A: Maths+Informatics Practices/Phy. Edu., Group B: Biology + Informatics Practices/Phy. Edu.

#### Commerce Stream:

Compulsory Subject: Accountancy, Business Studies, English, Economics & Informatics Practices/Phy. Edu.

#### **Transport Facility**

Bus facility is available to all the students who wish to avail it. Written application should be submitted to the school at the time of admission / new session.

Transport charges are to be paid for only eleven months in one academic year. No request for discontinuation of bus facility will be entertained during the academic year.

\*Please refer to Transport Leaflet for details of Bus Routes & Fare and Fee Book / Leaflet for Fee Structure and payment dates.\*

Fee must be paid by the 25<sup>th</sup> of each month (except Saturdays, Sundays & Holidays). Name will be struck off the rolls if the fee is not deposited for more than two months.

#### **Promotion Rules**

- For promotion the student is required to secure D grade in each subject and D grade in Aggregate.
- Class attendance of 75% is must for promotion.
- There will be no re-examination in the event of ABSENCE on account of any reason including MEDICAL.
- Promotion to STD-X and XII will be as per CBSE rules.

#### **LEAVE RULES**

- Absence without leave is seriously viewed and in case of six consecutive days of absence the name
  of the pupil shall be struck off the rolls.
- Class attendance of 75% is must for promotion. Permission to appear in Annual or Board exam will
  not be granted to those who fail to attain 75% Attendance during the Academic Session.

#### **Guidelines For Parents**

- Kindly visit the school's website regularly: www.davkhagaul.org
- Use the School Diary as a means of communication with the Class Teacher & check diary everyday for homework record and Teacher's remark, if any.
- Sign the test copies / papers as and when sent home.
- See that your ward has all the textbooks, items of stationery, craft materials etc. right in the beginning of the session.
- Ensure that all the books and notebooks are covered with brown paper.
- Ensure that your ward is regular and punctual to school. No absence will be permitted without a proper leave application and latecomers will not be allowed to sit in class.
- 75% attendance during the academic session is compulsory for promotion to the next class.
- Both the parents must attend the parent-teacher meets.
- Pay fees as per schedule. Fee once deposited can not be refunded.
- Intimate the school in case of any change in address or telephone number etc.
- Fill up the first page and other relevant 2 pages of the school diary as soon as the child gets it.
- Don't send your child to school if he/she is down with even slight fever or common cold. A medical certificate must be furnished from a medical authority at the time of rejoining the school, after an illness of over 4 days.
- Don't walk into the classroom or meet the Teacher in classroom. Please see the Teacher with prior appointment through the Principal.
- Don't visit the Teachers at their residence.
- Don't send money or any valuable article with the students. The School takes no responsibility if the same is lost. Mobile Phones are strictly not allowed.
- Be available on mobile/base phone after sending your ward to school.
- Parents should maintain proper and regular communication with the Class Teacher and Subject Teachers
